GNJILANE REGION

ATTEMPTED MURDER

Jerli Sadovina-0830 hrs. A complainant, ethnicity not know, reported that an identified Albanian male fired two rounds at him and his two daughters, while they were walking in a field. No injuries were reported.

ASSAULTS

Urosevac-2330 hrs. An Albanian male assaulted another Albanian male accusing him of stealing his car. The suspect was arrested.

Cernica-1300 hrs. An Albanian male threw rocks at a woman and her son. The suspect was detained.

Cernica-1834 hrs. Two Albanian males threw rocks at a Serb male. The suspects were detained.

MITROVICA REGION

ARSON

Brocnja-2200 hrs. Three unidentified gunmen went to a building supply store and threatened and chased the guard away by shooting in the air. The premises were set on fire. Motive in the case is not known.

Zvecan 1855 hrs. Three Serbs reported that two identified Albanian males set a garage on fire.

HUNGER STRIKE

Mitrovica North. 32 Serbian males, currently incarcerated in the Mitrovica detention center, are conducting a hunger strike. The hunger strikers are refusing all KFOR food. Contact KFOR Press for further information on this incident.

PEC REGION

MURDER

Djakovica-0900 hrs. UNMIK Police found the body of a week old infant on the roadside heading towards Prizren. Preliminary reports indicated that the child had died within the last 48 hours, apparently abandoned. No further information is available.

ARMED ROBBERY/GREIVIOUS ASSAULT

Rirza-0800 hrs. Two unidentified suspects, armed with automatic weapons, shot at a car driven by an Albanian male. The victim sustained injuries and stopped the vehicle. The masked suspects robbed the victim of his wallet. The victim then drove to the nearest residence and was driven to the hospital.

ASSAULT

Istok-0830 hrs. An unidentified suspect assaulted an Albanian male, while the man was collecting aid items from "Mother Teresa" NGO.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Djakovica-0200 hrs. Two South African males reported that the tires of their vehicle had been slashed while the vehicle was parked in front of Pastroku Hotel

MINE ACCIDENT

Kraljan-1415 hrs. KFOR reported that a "Norwegian People's Aid" employee, ethnicity unknown, stepped on a mine. The victim was evacuated to the military hospital in Pec and later airlifted to Pristina.

PRISTINA REGION**ARSON**

Kosovo Polje-0550 hrs. An Albanian house was set on fire. No injuries reported.

Kosovo Polje-0730 hrs. A Serb male reported that unknown suspects set his house on fire while he was away in Serbia. No injuries were reported.

PRIZREN REGION**ASSAULT**

Prizren-1315 hrs. An Albanian male reported that another Albanian male tried to steal his car but was unsuccessful and was arrested. The victim and a male co-worker were assaulted by the suspect. No serious injuries sustained.

ATTEMPTED KIDNAPPING

Prizren-1210 hrs. Three Albanian males were arrested for attempting to kidnap two other male victims.

ILLEGAL BORDER CROSSING

Krusevo-2000 Hrs. A patrol team arrested three males trying to cross the border illegally near the village of Krusevo. The three were returned to Albania.

SEXUAL ASSAULT

Sopina 1710 hrs. A fifteen-year-old Albanian female was offered a ride by a known Albanian male. As they were driving, the man pulled off and tried to rape the young female. She saw a KFOR patrol and jumped out of the vehicle. She was not injured.

BORDER POLICE**PRISTINA AIRPORT**

An Albanian male was denied boarding of a flight to Ljubljana when he was found to be in possession of a false passport. The suspect was processed and the passport was seized.

G. JANKOVIC BORDER CROSSING

A Albanian male was found in possession of a false passport while attempting to enter Kosovo. He also had a driver's license and identification card which had been obtained with the fake passport. All documents were seized and the suspect was processed and allowed to enter Kosovo.

G. JANKOVIC BORDER CROSSING

A driver of a civilian truck, hired by KFOR, driving from Kosovo to Macedonia, stopped his truck in front of the Greek checkpoint and sat on it's top. He blocked the road to protest the arrest and detention of a colleague of his by Macedonian Police. He was arrested by KFOR.
