UPDATE

01 JUNE, 2000

THIS UPDATE COVERS THE 24-HOUR PERIOD CONCLUDED AT MIDNIGHT 31 MAY, 2000.

GNJILANE REGION

BURGLARY

Urosevac-0700 hrs. An Albanian male reported a burglary in progress at his garage. UNMIK Police responded and arrested an Albanian male at the scene.

EXPLOSIONS

Kamenica-2330 hrs. Russian KFOR reported six explosions and gunfire. A patrol was sent out, but was unable to find anything. No injuries or damages reported.

MITROVICA REGION

ATTEMPTED MURDER

Vucitrn. An Albanian female assaulted her husband with an axe. No further information was available at the time of this report.

ASSAULT

Mitrovica North. A French national and the passengers of his vehicle with Albanian registration were assaulted by unidentified suspects.

THEFT

Mitrovica South -1115 hrs. A Belgian national reported that unidentified suspects had stolen three flak jackets from his vehicle.

PEC REGION

ATTEMPTED ARMED ROBBERY

Pec-0200 hrs. An Albanian male reported that while he was on duty at a warehouse, four armed gunmen entered the building and demanded money. No money was received and no injuries were reported.

DEMONSTRATION

Peje-2100 hrs. A group of local villagers gathered in front of a house that was being guarded by KFOR as the inhabitants are witnesses in a murder trial. The locals thought that they were Serbians that were being guarded because they had been working together during the war. After negotiations the group dispersed without incident.

PRISTINA REGION

MURDER/PUBLIC UNREST

Babin Mo st-1905 hrs. A 38-year-old Serb male was shot and died in a drive-by shooting. The father of the victim sustained injuries. A crowd of Serbs then tried to block the road to Mitrovica in order to protest against the murder. Three Norwegian soldiers were injured during the clashes and their vehicle was burned. Reinforcements were sent to the scene. KFOR arrested a Serb male (the victim's father) for armed attack on KFOR personnel and illegal possession of weapons. The situation calmed down about 2300 hrs.

GRENADE ATTACK

Obilic-2107 hrs. Unidentified suspects threw an explosive device at a Serb owned house. No injuries were reported but there was damage to the house.

Obilic-2150 hrs. Unidentified suspects threw an explosive device on the balcony of a Serb owned house. There were no injuries but damage to the residence.

Podujevo -0028 hrs. Unidentified suspects threw an explosive device into a shop. No injuries were reported. Ethnicity of the shop owner is not known.

PRIZREN REGION

SHOOTING

Russian KFOR check point-2300 hrs. Occupants of a vehicle fired two shots in the air and fled the scene. No injuries were reported.

BORDER POLICE

No significant criminal incidents were reported.
