UPDATE

02 JUNE, 2000

THIS UPDATE COVERS THE 24-HOUR PERIOD CONCLUDED AT MIDNIGHT 01 JUNE, 2000.
PREPARED BY 1100 HRS. ON 02 JUNE, 2000.

GNJILANE REGION

MURDER

Prelez-2300 hrs. An Albanian male was shot and was brought to the hospital. He was pronounced dead at the hospital. There were no further details at the time of this report.

MURDER/ATTEMPTED MURDER

Vitina-1500 hrs. One Serb female was shot dead and two Serbs were critically injured as the results of a drive-by shooting as they were working in a cornfield. The two injured were taken to Camp Bondsteel for treatment. No further information was available at the time of this report.

MURDER/VEHICULAR HOMICIDE

Blinca-1230 hrs. An elderly Serb female was struck and killed by a speeding motorist as she walked along the roadway. The driver of the car, an Albanian male, fled the scene of the accident but was arrested a short time later.

GRENADE ATTACK/ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF WEAPONS

Pasjane-1846 hrs. Two Serb females and one male were critically wounded as the results of a domestic dispute. A Serb male became angry and produced a hand grenade, which exploded in his hand, injuring him and the two women. They were taken to Camp Bondsteel for treatment. KFOR EOD and UNMIK RIU went to the scene and a search of the residence disclosed several weapons, which were seized.

ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF WEAPONS

Kacanik-0930 hrs. Two Albanian males were stopped by KFOR and a search of the suspects' vehicle revealed a machine gun and ammunition. The two men were arrested.

MITROVICA REGION

GRENADE ATTACK/ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF WEAPONS

Mitrovica North. An Albanian male reported that a group of Serbs had thrown a hand grenade at his house. No injuries were reported. Searches in the area resulted in the confiscation of two AK-47 rifles with ammunition. One weapon was found in the possession of an Albanian and one in the possession of a Serb.

TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS

Mitrovica South -1200 hrs. Two Albanian children were struck by a car. The victims sustained injuries. No further information available.

Mitrovica South-0130 hrs. An UNMIK Police patrol unit, responding to a call, was involved in a single vehicle accident when the driver lost control of the vehicle due to road conditions and struck a metal pole. Two UNMIK Police officers, a KPS officer and a language assistant were admitted to the hospital and after treatment all but one were released.

PEC REGION

ARSON

Klina-1515 hrs. An Albanian male reported that unidentified persons threw a Molotov cocktail inside his motel. The device exploded causing property damage but no physical injury.

PRISTINA REGION

GRENADE ATTACK

Obilic-2120 hrs. Unidentified suspects threw a hand grenade at a Serb owned house. One Serb sustained injuries and was evacuated to the KFOR hospital.

Obilic-2130 hrs. Unidentified suspects threw two hand grenades and fired shots at a Serb owned house. Minor property damage was reported but no physical injuries.

ARMED ASSAULT

Recak-2205 hrs. An Albanian male reported that unidentified suspects fired shots at him while he was in his fields. KFOR responded and recovered two rifles and ammunition. No injuries were reported.

DEMONSTRATION

Babin Most-1000 hrs. Approximately 60 Serbs protested against a homicide that had occurred the previous day. After negotiations with community leaders, the demonstration ended peacefully at 1800 hrs.

FATAL TRAFFIC ACCIDENT

Glogovac-1530 hrs. A 72-year-old Albanian male was struck by a vehicle and died shortly after arrival at the hospital. No further information available at the time of this report.

PRIZREN REGION

No report received.

BORDER POLICE

THREATS

Skoza-2015 hrs. UNMIK Border Police, along with KFOR, were flagged down and told that two armed Albanian males had threatened the local citizens. The patrol located the suspects and arrested them. No weapons were recovered.
