GNJILANE REGION

CAR THEFT

Gnjilane-0700 hrs. UNMIK Police attempted to stop a vehicle and the driver fled. After a short pursuit, the vehicle was stopped and determined to be stolen. The suspect, an Albanian male was arrested.

FORGED DOCUMENTS

In two separate incidents in Kacanik and Vitina, Albanian males were arrested for possession of forged driver's license.

MISSING PERSON

Ranilug-1920 hrs. An Albanian male reported that his father's car was located near the village several days ago, but the father had not been seen since. Investigation is ongoing.

MITROVICA REGION

GRENADE ATTACK

Mitrovica North -0030 hrs. Unidentified suspects threw a grenade at a Bosnian owned home. Minor property damage was reported but no physical injuries.

PEC REGION

MURDER

Glavicica-1700 hrs. An unidentified body of a young female was discovered. No further information is available. The investigation is ongoing.

SHOTS FIRED AT UNMIK POLICE

Kliina-Gjakova road-0210 hrs. An UNMIK Police patrol attempted to stop a vehicle with three occupants but the vehicle refused to stop. During the pursuit, 10 shots were fired towards the UNMIK Police vehicle. The type of weapon is unknown. UNMIK Police returned fire. The suspect vehicle escaped. No injuries were reported.

PRISTINA REGION

ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF WEAPON

Doberdol-1340 hrs. An alleged KPC/TMK member threatened to kill his female neighbor with an AK-47 rifle after a dispute over land. Later the suspect fired shots into the air. UNMIK Police and KFOR searched his house and found a trigger mechanism for a rocket launcher. The investigation is ongoing.

PRIZREN REGION

ATTEMPTED MURDER

Randubrava -1530 hrs. An Albanian male was shot five times with a handgun, outside his place of business by an identified Albanian male. The victim received emergency surgery at Prizren Hospital and he is expected to recover. The investigation is ongoing.

Zrze-0200 hrs. An Albanian male working as a security guard was shot and injured by unknown male suspects as he discovered a burglary in progress. The victim was transported to Orahovac hospital.

SHOTS FIRED AT RUSSIAN KFOR

Shots were fired at a Russian KFOR checkpoint in the Prizren region. No injuries were reported.

BORDER POLICE

Border Police continue to seize forged passports at border crossings in Kosovo. The number of forged documents being presented is on the increase.

GENERAL INFORMATION

WEEKLY REPORT

The weekly crime index shows the number of major crimes increased compared to the previous week (101/86).

9 murders were reported compared to 1 the previous week, 3 in Pristina, and 6 in Gnjilane regions. 8 victims were Serbian and 1 Albanian.

There were 16 attempted murders. 10 attempts were against Serbians and 6 against Albanians.

There were 9 kidnappings reported compared to 7 the previous week. 5 of these occurred in Pristina and 3 in Gnjilane.

Victims are 4 Albanians, 1 Serbian and 3 unidentified.

Cases of arson decreased. There were 11 cases reported compared to 17 the previous week. 6 cases were reported in Pristina, 1 in Prizren, 3 in Pec, 1 in Mitrovica and none in Gnjilane. Victims are 2 Serbians, 2 Albanians, 1 Bosnian and 6 unidentified.

8 grievous assaults were reported compared to 15 the previous week, including 4 in Pristina, 2 in Prizren, 1 in Mitrovica and 1 in Pec. Victims are 2 Albanians, 1 Serbian and 5 unidentified.

During the period under review, there were 128 arrests compared to 117 the previous week. 59 arrests in Pristina, 20 in Pec, 9 in Mitrovica, 19 in Prizren, 21 in Gnjilane. 24 arrests were made in regard to major crimes (14 the previous week), including 3 for homicide, 3 for grievous assault, 5 for rape, 4 for kidnapping, 3 for arson and 6 for attempted murder. There were also 7 arrests for drug offenses and one arrest for war crimes.

UNMIK Police took 457 reports compared to 476 the previous week. Since January 2000, 10,321 reports have been taken, including 133 murders, 67 kidnappings, 69 attempted murders, 25 attempted kidnappings and 178 grievous assaults. In regard to these particular 533 major crimes, 206 suspects have been arrested by UNMIK Police.
