UPDATE

12 JUNE, 2000

THIS UPDATE COVERS THE 24-HOUR PERIOD CONCLUDED AT MIDNIGHT 11 JUNE, 2000.
PREPARED BY 1100 HRS. ON 12 JUNE, 2000.

GNJILANE REGION

ASSAULT

Gnjilane-1400 hrs. UNMIK Police arrested three Albanian males for fighting. One suspect suffered serious knife injuries, while the other two sustained minor cuts.

MITROVICA REGION

MURDER

Krtigate-1330 hrs. Two Albanian males were shot and killed by a group of unidentified men. A third man was also seriously wounded in this same incident.

ASSAULT

Pruluzje-1645 hrs. Two UNMIK Police officers were attacked by an angry Serbian mob. The crowd gathered to stop a train running from Kosovo Polje to Zvecan. The officers were investigating a traffic accident at the time they were attacked. The officers were hit and kicked by the crowd and their vehicle was damaged.

THREATS

Two UNMIK Police officers reported that approximately 10 unidentified persons kicked in the door to their home and told the officers to leave their apartment.

ROBBERY

Mitrovica South-0030 hrs. An Albanian female was robbed of her vehicle and cash by two unidentified males and one unidentified female after being forced to stop her vehicle.

RAPE

Mitrovica South-1645 hrs. A 16-year-old Albanian female reported she was raped and assaulted by an identified Albanian male. The suspect threatened to kill the victim and her family if she reported the incident. The suspect was arrested.

CHILD ABANDONMENT

Mitrovica South -2030 hrs. A newborn infant was discovered abandoned by the mother after having been born on 10/06. The investigation is continuing.

PEC REGION**ROBBERY**

Dakovica-0300 hrs. An unidentified male assaulted an employee of a fuel station and stole money. No injuries were reported.

PRISTINA REGION**ARSON**

Kosovo Polje-2100 hrs. An unoccupied Serbian house was set on fire. The investigation is ongoing.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Stimlje-2155 hrs. An unidentified gunman fired several shots at an Albanian male's vehicle. As a result the vehicle caught fire and was totally destroyed. The vehicle was unoccupied at the time of the incident and no one was injured.

GRIEVOUS ASSAULT

Pristina-0910 hrs. An Albanian female, working as a Language Assistant for KFOR, reported that an unidentified male assaulted her. The victim required medical treatment.

PRIZREN REGION**THREATS**

Prizren-1545 hrs. A Turkish female was threatened with death by two Albanian males. The crime was motivated by her ethnic identity.

BORDER POLICE**FALSE DOCUMENTS**

Pristina Airport 1300 hrs. An Albanian male wanted to fly to Germany but was found to be in possession of a false Macedonian passport with a substituted photo. Another Albanian presented a false Norwegian Immigrants passport while attempting to board a flight to Ljubljana. The documents were confiscated and exit denied.
