THIS UPDATE COVERS THE 24-HOUR PERIOD CONCLUDED AT MIDNIGHT 15 JUNE, 2000.

GNJILANE REGION

ABDUCTION / ATTEMPTED RAPE

Urosevac-1900 hrs. A KFOR patrol observed a female jump out of a moving vehicle. The vehicle was stopped. Two Albanian females stated that they were being held against their will and had been assaulted by two Albanian males. One of the males allegedly attempted to rape one of the females. Both suspects were arrested.

MITROVICA REGION

ARMED ASSAULT

Mitrovica South -2300 hrs. An unidentified person in a black vehicle stopped in front of a Albanian café-bar and fired rounds from an AK-47 rifle through the windows. Although seven individuals were inside, no one was injured.

ASSAULT

Mitrovica North. A French employee of "Pharmaciens Sans Frontiere" was driving a vehicle with Kosovo registration plates when he was confronted by a group of Serbs who assaulted him. The victim received minor injuries.

Mitrovica North. An UNMIK Police patrol responded to an illegal house occupation call. A crowd of about 200 Serbs gathered and one "bridge watcher" assaulted an UNMIK interpreter. The interpreter was evacuated from the scene and an UNMIK Police car was attacked while taking her away.

ILLEGAL HOUSE OCCUPATION

Mitrovica North -1600 hrs. Serbs intimidated an Albanian male in the presence of a police officer. The victim was taken to UNMIK Police station for protection. Meanwhile, his apartment was occupied by a Serbian family. UNMIK Police and KFOR had to remove the illegal occupants.

PEC REGION

MURDER

Nabrdje-0015 hrs. Two unidentified masked gunmen forcibly entered a house of an Albanian family and shot two residents. One Albanian male died and another sustained injuries to his stomach. According to the victim's wife, assailants were wearing clothes with KLA/UCK patches.

MINE ACCIDENT

Lipovec-1630 hrs. An 18-year-old Albanian male attempted to remove an anti -personnel mine from a field and the mine exploded causing serious injury to the victim. The victim is in critical condition at a local hospital.

PRISTINA REGION

MURDER

Lepina-1110 hrs. Two Serbs were killed when the vehicle they were traveling in hit a landmine. A lone survivor from the explosion, who was the driver of the vehicle, was taken to the Russian KFOR hospital and remains in critical condition. KFOR at the scene, said the device was recently planted on the roadway.

MISSING PERSON

A KPS officer who was reported missing on 14/06 was located. The subject had missed his bus and was unable to return home at the time he was expected by his family. The subject was not abducted.

PRIZREN REGION

SEXUAL ASSAULT

Zrze-0930 hrs. An Albanian female reported that two known suspects assaulted her. No further information was available at the time of this report.

BORDER POLICE

No significant criminal incidents were reported.
