GNJILANE REGION

ASSAULT

Gnjilane-2055 hrs. An Albanian female reported that her husband beat her. The suspect was arrested.

FALSE DOCUMENTS

Kacanik-0010 hrs. Four Albanian drivers were found in possession of forged drivers license. The licenses were confiscated.

MURDER UPDATE

Gnjilane-2055 hrs. An update in reference to the drive-by shooting that occurred on the previous date, where three persons were killed and two were critically wounded. The suspect has been arrested and is being held at Camp Bondsteel detention.

MITROVICA REGION

THREATS

Mitrovica North -1000 hrs.. An Albanian male threatened the life of a KPS officer. The suspect was arrested.

GRENADE ATTACK

Mitrovica North -2026 hrs. An Albanian house was the target of a grenade attack. No injuries or property damage was reported.

ARMED ASSAULT

Mitrovica North. Unidentified persons fired shots through an apartment door of an Albanian flat. No injuries were reported.

DEMONSTRATION

Mitrovica North -1957 hrs. A demonstration took place with approximately 350 people gathered to protest the murders of several Serbs in the Gnjilane region. The demonstration ended peacefully.

PEC REGION**EXPLOSION**

Decani-0850 hrs. An Albanian male reported that unidentified persons had blown up his shop.

PRISTINA REGION**KIDNAPPING/RAPE**

Pristina. Four males kidnapped a husband and wife (ethnicity not ascertained), took them into a forest and raped the woman. Three suspects have been arrested so far in the case.

THREATS

Pristina-0740 hrs. Two Albanian males threatened a KPS officer. The suspects were arrested.

PRIZREN REGION**ARMED ROBBERY**

Orahovac-1130 hrs. An Albanian family reported that four unidentified males, armed with AK-47 rifles forcibly gained access to their house and ransacked a room. The owner of the house confronted the suspects with an axe. The suspects left the house taking some jewelry.

Lozica-1040 hrs. An Albanian male approached a KFOR checkpoint and reported that three males, armed with an AK-47 rifle stopped his vehicle. Three shots were fired at his car. The suspects took the victim's documents, cash and a mobile phone. No injuries were reported.

ASSAULT ON KFOR

Unidentified suspects attacked a Russian KFOR checkpoint with assault rifles and a rocket launcher. The grenade did not explode.

DRUGS

Prizren-1745 hrs. An Albanian male was arrested when he tried to escape from a KFOR checkpoint. The suspect was found in possession of heroin following a search.

BORDER POLICE**EXPLOSION**

Korbuljic-1550 hrs. An Albanian male was brought to the border crossing point after he had stepped on a mine. KFOR provided first aid and the victim was airlifted to Camp Bondsteel.
